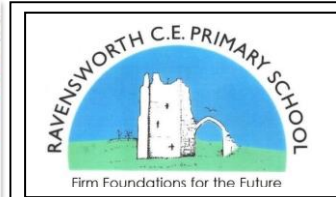


## **Democracy**

- Talent show auditions
- Children involved in topic planning
- Children vote weekly on school awards in Celebration Collective Worship

## **Rule of Law**

- Consistent approach across the school to behaviour – behaviour policy
- Police (road safety, stranger danger)/fire safety/e-safety talks
- Parental questionnaires
- Sports code of conduct adhered to during events
- SMSC and SEAL curriculum followed
- Bikeability (Year 6)
- Crucial Crew (Year 6)
